Practice and **revise** past topics that I find difficult.

Asking teachers for extra **revision materials**.

Use a separate book for important subjects, where I **rewrite notes** I need to revise neatly.

Revise when I know I have a test or assessment.



Read books that are complicated, higher level and to improve my word range.

I try to do the same tasks at home but more **challenging** versions.

Ask my teacher if I have done my work wrong and how I can **improve** my **understanding**.

Do **homework** the day you get it!

Make **learning** fun for yourself!

Organising my work, revision schedule and knowing when my tests are.



Revise for 30 minutes everyday about topics that you have learnt in school to make sure it sticks and you **remember** it.



Ask as many questions as possible during lessons.

Revising at home with online Apps or using textbooks for certain subjects.

Always **listen** to the tips that your teacher gives you.

Look back over my work to ensure I **understand** it.

Pack my bag the night before school.



I put my **hand up** even if I am not sure of an answer.

Pay attention in class.

Discussing work with my friends.

When I don't **understand** a topic, I will ask my teachers questions until I understand.

Revising what I don't understand at home on the **same day**.

Complete tasks to the best of your **ability** and if you don't get something always ask.
